

General information about The Faroese Weapons Permit

National Weapons Permit Authority

The Weapons Permit is issued by the Environmental Agency of the Faroe Islands (Umhvørvisstovan).


The Weapons Permit gives right to:

- Own and use smoothbore shotguns.
- To import and export these smoothbore shotguns to and from the Faroe Islands.
- The Weapons Permit does not give the right to own and use rifles, or to import or export rifles etc.

Legal information

The Faroese Weapons Permit is issued in accordance with Faroese Act. No. 43 of 22nd of May 1969 about weapons etc., as amended by Act. No. 54 of 12nd of May 1980 and Act No. 81 of 22nd of May 2015. The Weapons Act is under the auspices of the Prime Minister's Office of the Faroe Islands.
